Another year has come and gone and with it four of our students have graduated and are now out in the world. You have made a difference in the life of these students. The Alumni Board would like to thank you, every membership renewal enables us to keep up the good work we have been doing for over 24 years.

Scholarships

Beginning with the school year 2005/2006 the alumni association awarded 5 scholarships each year to deserving students unfortunately in 2012/2013 we could only award 3 and due to the economy things got worse so in 2013/2014 we only awarded 2. As the association runs solely on donations we are limited in our scholarships. Three students will graduate this year and we have funds committed to the other eight that are currently enrolled in various schools... The alumni have been kept since the 1990/91 school year and we have awarded 75 scholarships, 28 students failed to renew their scholarship some attending for one or two semesters and then stopped, reason unknown. Another 8 students graduated in 2 years from community college and 28 students graduated after 4 years. Because of your generosity we have awarded \$219,250.00 over the years. Each time you renew your Alumni Association membership another student goes to college to help make this a better world.

We are trying to recruit additional alumni to keep our cause going, can you help? Let anyone you know that graduated from North High know about our program and have them contact anyone of the Board officers.

Mentor of the Year

For the 2012-2013 school years the scholarship recipients chose educator for the \$500 Mentor of the Year award. This is the fourteenth consecutive year this award has been made by the North High School Alumni Association – a proud tradition and founded by a member of the North High Alumni who graciously donates the funds for this worthy cause so the scholarship monies are never touched.
