Dear North High Alumni and Friends:

Last Spring (2005), we started an aggressive drive to generate additional scholarship monies for deserving North High graduates. Many thanks to all of you who continued your Association dues and contributed additional dollars. And thanks, too, to those of you who just joined our Alumni Association this past year.

As some of you may remember, last year's scholarship winners were Jennifer McKay, Veronica Franco, Graciela Viveros, Kimberly Bradford and Cayetano Ordonez. Because of your generosity during the year, at this coming May's Awards Assembly we will again award five scholarships, each worth \$6,000! With ever increasing college fees, the additional assistance made possible by your donations is definitely needed and appreciated.

Some Highlights from the Second Half of 2005

- Zachary Munoz, Acting Principal of North for the past year, was named permanent Principal as of June 2005.
- The Association recognizes an outstanding teacher every year with the F.V. Bud Brown Award; the 2005 Award went to Tom Dugan, who received a \$500 check at the first faculty meeting last August.
- Aaron Berkowitz, Alumni Association Founding President and Current Board Member, was a Junior Achievement teacher this past fall semester.
- The Alumni Association Board awarded \$750 to North High for holiday food gift baskets, under the direction of Principal Zachary Munoz.
- Two North High graduates from the 1990s now teach in the Phoenix Union High School District. It is gratifying to note that they *both were past Alumni Association scholarship winners*.
- North High was recognized last summer by Newsweek's annual Best High Schools list of the Top 1000. Only three Arizona high schools made the list. (Last year North produced the most International Baccalaureate Diploma candidates in the state, as well as twelve National Merit semi-finalists. There are currently 350 students in the IB program, which puts North in the top 4% of U.S. high schools.)
- Phoenix Mayor Gordon recently recognized the North High swim team for academic excellence. The girls' team was awarded first place, and the boys' team got second place.
