2004 was a very successful year, and we more than met our goals. In 2005, we hope for many more dues-paying members, since membership dues account for 90% of our yearly contributions. *Dues for 2005 are only \$25.00 per person. payable by May 1, 2005. On-time payments are important. because that is when our scholars* for the following fall semester.

Recognizing that all in-state community college and university fees have been raised, we have increased our assistance to our deserving scholars. Presently we assist 16 graduates: the amount of each scholarship does not even cover community college registration fees any longer, but it certain does help immensely!

Since the 1998-'99 school year, we have assisted 35 students, spent approaching \$51,500 of your donations and membership fees, and received many letters of thanks for the Association's help!

Please join us in support of this scholarship program by renewing your own membership, and by making any further contributions you can afford. We have the capability to process investments/endowments well in excess of the \$25 annual dues, and your added contributions are greatly appreciated by the students and their families.
